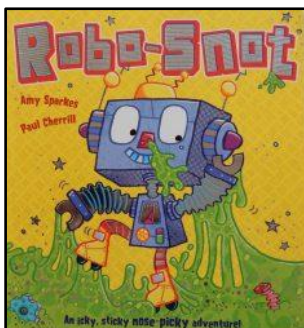


**Non- Pupil Day**
