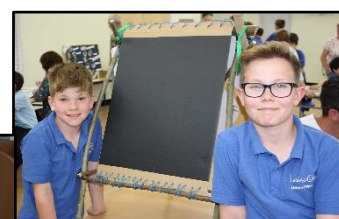
### **Scrap Material Requirements:**

**Wood:** bowls, broom handle, chair parts, clothes pegs, coat-hangers, cotton reels, cricket bats, cricket stumps, curtain rings, dowel, drawer handles, egg-cups, rolling pins, softwood off-cuts, spatulas, spoons, table tennis bats : tool handles (*no MDF, Plywood or Chipboard*)

**Metal:** badminton racquets, bicycle wheels, bottle tops, brackets chain, colander, copper pipe, door handles, hinges, jar lids, keys, nuts, sieve, spoons, springs, wire coat-hangers
