Library Summer Reading Challenge: 'Marvellous Makers'



All children are invited to join the free, fun Summer Reading Challenge which runs through the summer holidays. The challenge is to read 6 books and they can be any books of the child's choice: audiobooks, ebooks, fiction, non-fiction, early readers, comic books, joke books, poetry books, graphic novels ... they all count. After every two books, they go to the library and collect stickers for their folder and after they have read all 6 books, they will receive a medal and a certificate. There is also a prize draw and they will then be entered and, as

you can see from the photo, there are many prizes to be won. As well as individual prizes, there is also a prize to be won for the local school that has the highest percentage of pupils finishing the Summer Reading Challenge.

Children can also take part in the challenge online at summerreadingchallenge.org.uk where they set a reading goal and can unlock digital rewards including a PDF certificate.

There are also lots of fun things to sign up for at CREDITON LIBRARY. These are in addition to regular activities (like the drop-in Lego and Duplo club at 4pm on Mondays). When you pop into CREDITON LIBRARY look out for the library trail where you can find 'Marvellous Makers' character pictures hidden around the library. There will also be an exhibition wall in September where you can look at what children's favourite summer reads are.
