My name is Jude, and I am a trainee Education Mental Health Practitioner (EMHP) working with Landscore Primary School. We are part of the Mental Health Support Team (MHST) for schools in Children & Family Health Devon.

MHST deliver evidence based individual and group interventions for children who need extra support for mild to moderate anxiety or low mood, or behaviour difficulties. We also work with staff and whole classes delivering workshops and training around mental health and promoting positive emotional wellbeing at your child's school.
