Dear Parents and Carers,

Well, we are putting September to bed and heading into October next week – how quickly the month has passed! As we get into the heart of autumn, it is lovely to see the season change around us. The children always seem to be filled with awe at the changing leaves and shine on conkers... why not join them?

#### School Census Day

Please remember that next **Thursday**, **3**<sup>rd</sup> **October**, is our census day which is when we have to report our pupil numbers and the number of children who have eaten a school meal on that day. These figures will then be used to calculate our budget for the following year. It is vital that as many children as possible, particularly from KS1 and Reception, order and take a meal on that day, <u>even if they don't normally have one</u>.

Please strongly encourage your child to have a school meal on that day as it will help the school's funding for next year. The children may also bring their packed lunch if they want to but will still be able to take a school meal and try it. Thursday is our pizza day - which is one of our most popular days - and I am sure most of the children will be happy to have a school dinner that day!

#### Attendance

Attendance is a very high priority nationally and it is important that children attend school regularly. The DfE has updated its requirement on schools this year to help improve school attendance and they have made their expectations clear about what parents should do and what schools should do to improve attendance:

#### Parents should:

- Try to telephone the school before 8.30am each day of your child's absence and leave a message.
- Tell the school in advance, of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters.
- Have a backup plan in case you cannot get your child to school, call on a family member, neighbour or friend.
- If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance, then talk to the school as a first step so they can help!

#### School will:

- Check your child's attendance every day.
- Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.
- Invite you into school for attendance meetings if there are concerns.

#### **Absences**

Please ensure that all absences are reported to the school office as soon as possible, and at the latest by 9:00am. Please leave a message on the answerphone, which is regularly checked, and include details of the reason for absence too. If we do not hear from you, then we will try to contact you by 10:00am and may also have to follow up with a home visit in line with our safeguarding policy and procedures.

#### Black History Month

During October, we will be celebrating Black History Month in school. Black History Month gives everyone the opportunity to share, celebrate and understand the impact of black heritage and culture and to remember important people and events from African communities.



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#### Harvest Assembly

We will be holding our Harvest Celebration next week on **Friday 4**<sup>th</sup> **October**. Each team will be performing a harvest song or poem to the rest of the school.

We are asking for donations of food on that day for us to give to the Crediton Foodbank. The charity provides emergency food parcels for local people who are in need and as you can appreciate, the demand for this is constantly rising. The foodbank would really appreciate any food donations which are **non-perishable**, i.e. any **tinned or packaged food such as pasta**, **rice**, **macaroni cheese**, **jars of sauce**, **baked beans**, **tinned vegetables or fruit**, **tinned meats**, **soup**, **cereals**, **tinned ready meals**, **rice pudding**, **custard**, **teabags**, **coffee**, **sugar**, **jam** etc. They are also very grateful for any toiletries such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo and soap.
