


The Anglo Saxons began to settle alongside the Britons in 400AD.

The Battle of Hastings happened in 1066 and William the Conqueror won the Battle of Hastings and became the new King of England.



Synopsis

As Historians, we will be finding out about who the Vikings were and what happened when they invaded Britain in 787AD. We will look at why the Vikings invaded Britain and what life was like during this time.

Key Knowledge

The **Vikings** came from the modern Scandinavian countries of Denmark, Norway and Sweden. They travelled in boats called **longships** and first arrived in Britain around 787AD. The Vikings raided places such as monasteries and pillaged expensive items to trade. The Vikings wanted to claim land and tried to take over much of Britain. They invaded and settled in Scotland before heading south across England. By 878AD the Vikings had settled permanently in Britain. The Viking's farming techniques, language and laws spread across the north and east of England. Traditional Viking families had men working the land, with a wife taking care of the home and of the family valuables. When they first arrived, most Vikings followed pagan religions, but soon converted to Christianity as they became settled in England. In 1066 William the Conqueror invaded England and the Viking rule in England came to an end.
